



## Instructions for "18" Doll Nylon Tulle Underskirt

### Supplies Needed:

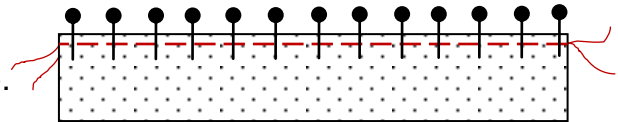
- Tulle – 3 pieces cut to 6" x 38"  
same or different color
- 1" elastic – 10 inches
- Regular Sewing Thread – same color as elastic
- Sewing Machine



**STEP 1:** CUT 3 pieces Tulle 6" x 38"  
- Tulle can be cut 36" – 40" depending on what works for the tulle width you have.

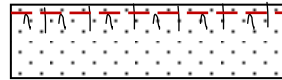
**STEP 2:** LAYER the tulle on top of each other – pin the long edge securely.  
- Tulle is very slippery and loves to move around

**STEP 3:** STITCH using a long stitch length on the long edge.

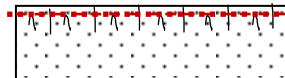


**STEP 4:** GATHER the tulle by pulling the bobbin thread so it is approx 18" long.

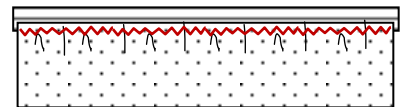
**STEP 5:** ADJUST the gathers evenly.



**STEP 6:** STITCH over the gathering line using a regular stitch length (2.5 – 3mm)  
to securely lock the gathering stitches .



**STEP 7:** ATTACH elastic to gathered edge of tulle, stretching the elastic as you go.  
- place elastic next to the feed dogs, lay gathered tulle about 1/2" over the edge  
and topstitch in place using a medium zig zag stitch.  
- mark elastic and tulle skirt into four equal parts - match these marks as stitch



**STEP 8:** STITCH the ends of the elastic together. Place one end over the other overlapping the  
ends by 1/2". Topstitch a square onto the elastic, securing all edges of the overlap.  
- No need to stitch the tulle, it overlaps and hangs better if not stitched.
